

AGENDA FOR
RECREATIONAL COACHES MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, AUGUST 27, 2019

The following are minutes/highlights from last night's coaches meeting:

Craig Blackburn, SAC Executive Director, called the meeting to order at 8 pm.

SAC President Bob Grandfield welcomed the coaches and thanked them for volunteering.

V/P of Recreation, Wilma Moran Wylie welcomed the coaches and thanked them for all their hard work

Chuck Bode, SAC V/P, introduced SAC sponsor Bob Lucido and Bob said a few words. Chuck then introduced Tony Rodriguez, Classic Photography. Tony presented a sponsorship check for \$15,000 to the Club.

John Ellinger, SAC Technical Director, and Aki Lake, Recreation Director discussed the following:

- Registration for Recreation/Select technical training is currently open for both individuals and team training.
- Registration for Recreation/Select goalkeeper training is currently open
- Training manuals are on the website for coaches training
- There are also manuals from Southampton on the website

- Grassroots training courses are being held at SAC, please go the MSYSA website to see times and dates. SAC reimburses the 11v11 course

Bob Grandfield discussed some risk management guidelines

- Background checks are mandatory for all coaches
- Restrict one and one interaction with players
- Moving/assembling goals can only be done by adults

Scott McVicker V/P of Facilities

- Complex managers are assigned to the facility during game days. Any issues please come and see them, they are usually by the coaches' room
- There is an off-duty police officer on duty on for the weekends. His job is not to direct traffic but is there to deter crime
- SAC has a crossing guard on weekends located by the SAC Clubhouse
- Parking can be difficult at times, we are moving the U7 offsite which should help on Saturdays
- Lock your car and don't leave valuables in them

- Lightning Detector -one long siren clear the fields and go to your cars, if your game has started it is now over. If any doubt, there is a flashing light on top of the building if there is an active alert. All clear is three short siren blasts
- Please pick up your trash after your game/practice, even if it isn't your trash please pick it up.

Craig Blackburn went over the following general notices

- Athletic House will pick up uniforms to have numbers put on the jerseys which is included in the registration fee. Names are not required but can be put on for an extra fee, \$4.00 per jersey plus tax. Athletic house will be at SAC on Wednesday(tomorrow) from 5-8 pm to pick up the jerseys. If we can get the jerseys by Friday COB 4:30 they should be ready for the first game
- All rec games except 2013(U7) and 2006/2005 will be at Covenant Park. 2006/2005 will be at county high school fields and the 2013 age group will be at Howard Community College
- Permitted board of Ed fields are on the website under the programs tab and then rec, permitted fields. SHARE THE FIELDS

- Board of Education permitted fields are on the website, under programs tab, recreation, permitted fields. SHARE THE FIELDS

Eric Finney, SAC IT Director, discussed the following

- Rain make up procedure was discussed, rainouts on Saturdays will be made up on a future Sunday, Sunday rainouts will be made up on a future Saturday. Friday rainouts could be either Saturday or Sunday depending on field availability
- Coaches can not cancel games, if you are short players have the players show up and scrimmage
- No games Columbus Day weekend
- Select schedules have been released, recreation should be later this week. High school schedules will be next week
