

Bracketing Structure

Bracket Size	Format	Details
4 Teams	Round Robin, Championship	Teams will compete in a single group. The group competes in round-robin play for a total of 3 games per team. After these games are completed, the highest seeded team (the team with the most points) will play the second highest seeded team (the team with the second most points) in a Championship match. At the completion of the finals, the involved teams should proceed to site headquarters for the trophy presentation.
5 Teams	Round Robin	5 team divisions will play a round-robin style tournament for a total of 4 games per team. The finalist and champion will be determined by points at the conclusion of round-robin play (no playoff games).
6 Teams (3A 3B)	Round Robin, Semifinals, Championship	The teams are divided into two groups of 3 teams each. Each group competes in round-robin play for a total of 2 games per team. After this stage, the teams are seeded by points to determine the semi-finalists. The first semi-final will feature the highest seeded team in Group A vs the second seeded team from Group B. The second semi-final will the highest seeded team in Group B vs the second seeded team from Group A. The winners of the 2 semi-finals will proceed to the finals. The lowest seeded teams (third seed) will meet in a consolation match. The consolation match can end in a tie. At the completion of the finals, the involved teams should proceed to site headquarters for the trophy presentation.
7 Teams (4A 3B)	Round Robin, One Semifinal, Championship	<u>Group A</u> : The four teams in Group A will play 3 round-robin games apiece. After these games are completed, the highest seeded team in Group A (the team with the most points) will proceed directly to the finals. The second seeded team in Group A will have a fourth consolation game against the last place (third seeded) team in Group B. The consolation game can end in a tie. <u>Group B</u> : The three teams in Group B will play two round-robin games. After these games are completed, the three

teams in Group B will be seeded by points. The top two seeded teams in Group B will meet in a single semi-final game with the winner proceeding to the finals. The lowest seeded team in Group B will play the second seeded team from Group A in a consolation match. The consolation game can end in a tie. **At the completion of the finals, the involved teams should proceed to site headquarters for the trophy presentation.**

8 Teams (4A 4B)

Round Robin,
Championship

The teams are divided into two groups of 4 teams each. Each group competes in round-robin play for a total of 3 games per team. After this stage, the top seeded team from each group will proceed to the finals. **At the completion of the finals, the involved teams should proceed to site headquarters for the trophy presentation.**
